

HANUKAH BLESSINGS

The first two blessings are said on each night:

בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה יי אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, אֲשֶׁר קִדְּשָׁנוּ בְּמִצְוֹתָיו,
וְצִוָּנוּ לְהַדְלִיק נֵר שֶׁל חֲנֻכָּה.

*Baruh atah adonay eloheynu meleh ha'olam asher kideshanu bemitzvotav
vitzevanu lehadlik ner shel hanukah.*

Blessed are you, Holy One, life of all worlds, who invites us to be holy and kindle the Hanukah lights.

בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה יי אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, שֶׁעָשָׂה נִסִּים לְאַבוֹתֵינוּ בַּיָּמִים הָהֵם בַּזְּמַן הַזֶּה.

*Baruh atah adonay eloheynu meleh ha'olam sheh'asah nissim la'avoteynu
bayamim haheim baseman hazeh.*

Blessed are you, Holy One, life of all worlds, who preformed miracles for our ancestors at this season in ancient days.

Shehehyanu is said only on the first night:

בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה יי אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, שֶׁחַיָּינו וְקִיָּמָנוּ וְהִגִּיעָנוּ לַזְּמַן הַזֶּה.

*Baruh atah adonay eloheinu meleh ha'olam shehehyanu, vekiyamanu
behigi'anu lazeman hazeh.*

Blessed are You, Holy One, life of all worlds, who gave us life and kept us strong and brought us to this time.
